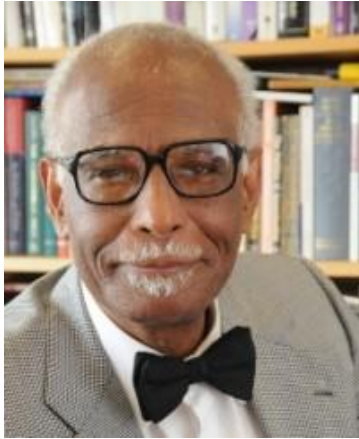


Winston Langley
